On Sunday, June 29, 1975, Steve Wozniak took an old Motorola 6800 CPU and electronic components and soldered to a motherboard. He started it and showed it to his good friend Steve Jobs, which in the end was the prototype for the Apple I, the world's first personal computer for the consumer market.
